Lowell Hill Pottery and the Rowantrees Tradition

Rowantrees Pottery was founded in 1934 by Adelaide Pearson, first as a community art class free to all residents of Hancock County and then as a pottery cooperative. Pearson was a very perceptive person and, with World War II approaching, knew that the fine china Americans treasured would soon be difficult or impossible to obtain. She and her partner Laura Paddock embarked on a worldwide tour of potteries with the idea of setting a new course for the fledgling cooperative. Encouraged (nee scolded) by Mahatma Gandhi to take pottery more seriously, they returned to Blue Hill with a new purpose.

Rowantrees Pottery was the result of that trip. In a few short years, Rowantrees became famous the world over for its unique shapes, colors and quality. The pottery continued operation until 2008 when its last owner, Sheila Varnum retired. She had worked at Rowantrees for virtually her entire life. Upon her retirement, Rowantrees quietly closed its doors after almost 75 years of continuous operation.

Varnum was concerned that the Rowantrees tradition of unique colors and forms should not disappear when the doors closed, so she began talking with former Rowantrees potter Geoff Miller. Miller had worked at Rowantrees under Varnum's tutelage from 1982 to 1990 and was hoping to start his own pottery.

Miller began researching and testing new clays and glazes in an effort to update the products. Rowantrees glazes had been made with lead, which was not an option. In addition, the local clay would require a good deal of equipment and space that Miller did not have.

In 2010 Miller opened Lowell Hill Pottery in the old Rowantrees facility. Lowell Hill operated seasonally until 2014 when the building was put on the market and Miller had to move out. The pottery was down for the following two years while maintaining an online presence through its website.

In 2016 Miller had a new studio built next to his house. In 2018 he stepped down from his job of 28 years to devote himself full-time to Lowell Hill Pottery.

Lowell Hill Pottery is dedicated to making certain that the beautiful forms and colors made famous by Rowantrees Pottery remain available well into the future. All items are handmade from red earthenware clay and decorated with glazes of my own making. Local materials are used when possible.

At Lowell Hill Pottery I respect the past and keep an eye on the future.












Wholesale Terms and Conditions

Minimum Order - Minimum wholesale orders are \$250 for the first purchase. There is no minimum order for established wholesale customers after the first purchase.

Payment Terms – New customers must prepay prior to shipping. Established customers may pay net 30 days. I reserve the right to cancel 30-day privileges for failure to pay in a timely manner.

Sales Tax Information – Please include a copy of your sales tax exemption certificate or, at a minimum, your sales tax ID with your order. Failure to provide this information will result in a sale tax charge.

Limitations – Wholesale orders may be placed at any time during the year. Orders placed after April 1 or September 30 are subject to stock availability and delivery dates cannot be guaranteed. Lowell Hill Pottery will sell wholesale to only one business entity in a municipality. I do not grant contracts for exclusive territories. If you are buying for shops in more than one town please be sure to inform me.

Shipping - Lowell Hill Pottery ships via the most cost-effective carrier based on cost comparisons made at the time of shipping. If you have a carrier preference (USPS or UPS) please be sure to let me know. When possible, I will also deliver wholesale orders myself to purchasers within a two-hour drive from my location. This is especially true if I will be making multiple deliveries. Shipping charges will still apply in these cases.

Variations - Lowell Hill Pottery is made one piece at a time by hand. As such, minor variations in size, shape and color common to hand-crafted products are to be expected. Every effort is made to assure that all pieces sold in a set are as closely matched as possible. It is not possible to guarantee a perfect match to items you may already own.

Swap Out – All sales are final. Buyers may swap out items of equal value if desired. Swap outs are not limited by the dates mentioned above, but are subject to availability. Buyers are responsible for all shipping costs when swapping items. I will only exchange items that arrive intact. Please contact me to arrange a swap.

Warranty - Lowell Hill Pottery does warranty its products against manufacturing defects. However, I do reserve the right to examine pieces that may have been damaged due to such defects. I further reserve the right to determine if defects in manufacture were the cause of the damage. Every effort is made to assure that pottery leaving my shop is entirely free of defects but I cannot assume any responsibility for the manner in which pottery is handled after it leaves my hands (with the exception of breakage during shipping - read on).

Breakage During Shipping - Check your merchandise immediately after you receive it. If you find any damage, please read and follow the instructions included with your shipment. The instructions vary depending on the carrier.

Ordering Information

Placing an order – Orders may be placed by phone, email, or by using the enclosed order form. Established accounts will be given login access to the wholesale buyer portal on my website as well. The date restrictions noted in the Terms and Conditions above will apply to online as well as other modes of ordering. Do not pay at the time of ordering. I will invoice you when your order is ready. If this is your first order, I will ship your order once payment is received.

Shipping – Shipping charges will be calculated and invoiced along with the rest of your order. Do not add any shipping charges onto your order.
